



Grey Wolf Award

Prior to commencing the Grey Wolf Award a NSW Grey Wolf Commencement Form must be completed and handed to your Cub Scout Leader. This form can be downloaded from our website:

In order to earn the Grey Wolf Award your child will need family guidance and support. The Cub Leaders will ensure that Boomerang requirements are scheduled into the program and will organise activities that your child can participate in that satisfy the outdoor requirements. All the requirements for the Award should be completed soon after your child is 10 and a half. The Achievement and Special Interest Badges can be started at any time. There is quite a bit of effort involved in these badges, so your child will need help scheduling their time, and learning how to divide a task into small steps. Please ensure that you send an email or a signed letter to Cubs detailing any work that is completed at home, school etc.
