#### What is the NSW Active Kids Rebate Program?

Active Kids is a NSW Government program which helps families across the State meet the costs of enrolling their children into recreation, sport and active fitness activities, such as Scouts!

Every child (4.5 - 18 years old) enrolled in school from Kindergarten to Year 12 is eligible for an Active Kids voucher. This includes those who are home-schooled or enrolled in secondary education at TAFE NSW.

The two \$100 Active Kids vouchers go towards covering Scouts NSW membership fees (a component of your total term fee), and the one off joining fee if your child is a new member. The Group fee is not covered by the Active Kids rebate voucher. The two vouchers must be redeemed in two different terms.

#### When Will I Receive My Rebate

Scouts NSW is a registered activity provider and they are responsible for administrating the system. All vouchers are to be registered at Scouts NSW. The Group is not responsible for registering your Active Kids voucher.

Scouts NSW, after validating the voucher they receive will apply it against quarterly registration fees. The \$100 is not credited in a lump sum, it is applied to the quarterly invoice that each individual Scout Group is billed as per the following:

***Vouchers cannot be split between different activity providers, are not retrospective, and cannot be refunded if you child resigns from Scouting. Each voucher is only valid for redemption during the calendar year it was issued.***

#### What Happens to All Unused Active Kids Rebate Credits?

With permission from the NSW Office of Sport, all unused Active Kids rebate credits will be disbursed to the Scouts NSW Family Support Fund at the conclusion of each year to assist current and

prospective youth members and young Leaders in genuine need of financial support with the cost of Scouting.

### **How to Claim My Rebate**

**Step 1: Visit the Service NSW online portal** to register for and download your Active Kids Rebate Voucher:

Please note that you will need to enter the voucher number in order to redeem it with Scouts NSW.

**Step 2: Redeem the voucher with Scouts.** Visit:

The voucher will not be validated and applied until the youth member application form has been approved, once your child has been invested.
