Membership and Parental Responsibilities

Thank you for the opportunity of allowing your youth to continue being a part of our Group. We will continue to aim at contributing to their development and life skills provided through training, experiences and guidance from our valued Leaders.

Our Group is completely operated by volunteers. Our Leaders, Adult Helpers and Committee Members are not paid for the work that they undertake for our Group, which is often on top of their existing professional occupations. They do this to support the Group, contribute to our Youth and for their own personal satisfaction. All of this extra work does not just magically happen and as Parents we must do our utmost best to support them in these roles.

Scouting is a self-help community organisation, and the success of any Group can be attributed to a high level of family support. This document is a reminder of your responsibilities and how you can help to provide that support.

Your Responsibilities

As a Parent of a member of the Group you are required to:

- serve on a Parent Helper roster at Section meetings (as required)
- ensure that your member is dropped off and picked up on time for meetings and any activities
- ensure that Joey and Cub members are physically escorted into and out from the hall – for safety reasons please do not drop them off at or outside the gate
- provide assistance (where required) to your child/youth and encourage Award progression
- assist the Leaders by becoming a regular Parent Helper - this may include regular assistance at weekly meetings, weekend outings, hikes and camps etc.
- pay fees on time
- assist with fundraising – such as Bunnings BBQs and the Fertiliser Drive
- assist the Committee by volunteering your skills at Working Bees
- attend the Group Annual Presentation Night – a parent/guardian from each family must attend this meeting

take on a Committee position – Chairperson, Deputy Chairperson, Secretary, Treasurer, Trustee etc.

undertake training to become a Leader – come join the fun – our Leaders are mostly just parents – that have allocated time in their busy lives to ensure that we can offer the youth members a great Scouting experience
