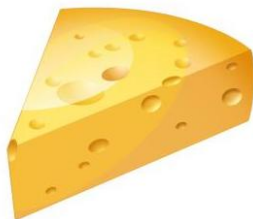

Compass Bingo

Activity: Compass Bingo

Equipment – A sheet of paper divided into squares for each person (like a bingo card) – 9 or 16 squares are good.

A master card filled in for the Leader running the game

The Leader has a master card, with items pre-drawn in it. For example, in the top left corner might be the letter A, next to it a kite, next to that a hat, etc. Each space in the “bingo” card should be filled with something that is easy to draw.

The Leader describes the location of a square using the compass points, and then tells the Joeys what goes in that square. Continue until all the squares have been marked off.

E.g. find the squares that are at the north. Now go to the square that is as far west as you can go. Put an A there. Now go two squares to the east and one square to the south. Draw a tree there. Continue until all squares are filled.
